Our world is changing and many individuals and organisations are calling attention for the need to rethink education and to implement urgent changes in pedagogy, curricula, teaching practices and learning methods.

Transversalskills, such as creativity, critical thinking, problem solving, communication and collaboration for common goals, are essential for young people to be able to compete in the modern world and global economy, and to guarantee, as well, a qualified and entrepreneurial workforce in Europe.

In this changing and challenging educational context, the D-THINK project emerged in 2014 as an initiative of 7 partners from 6 different European countries, supported by the Erasmus+ Programme of the European Commission. The project aims to promote a wider use of Design Thinking as a transversal learning tool to redesign learning experiences, and it included the development and dissemination of an innovative toolkit and a digital course for educators and professional trainers.
